## PEMS 27<sup>th</sup> Annual Convention (2007)

PEMS held its 27th Annual Convention on 24 November 2007 at the CSLAB Auditorium, UP Diliman, Quezon City. The theme of the convention was "Emerging Diseases in a Changing Environment". Dr. Windell Rivera of the Institute of Biology, UP Diliman talked on 'Enteric opportunistic protozoans in immunocompromised hosts', Dr. Alyssa Peleo-Alampay of the National Institute of Geological Sciences, UP Diliman talked on 'The Truth of Global Warming Today" and Dr. Alvin Marcelo Director, UP Manila National Telehealth Center and Chief, UP College of Medicine Medical Informatics Unit of UP Manila talked on 'Emerging Opportunities for Research in E-Health'.

PEMS members and other interested researchers are invited to submit abstracts of their papers for poster presentation. Poster papers should be original researches related to biodiversity, mutagenesis / antimutagenesis and related topics. The abstract must include: introduction,

significance of study, objectiv methodology, results, discus conclusion, recommendation Instructions for the submissio abstracts include the followir

1. Title of abstract should be we to 10 pt Bold Arial or Times New Roman.

- 2. Names of authors and affiliations should be written in 10-pt Italic Arial or Times New Roman. Underline the name of the presenting author. Include email address of the presenting author.
- 3. Title, authors' names, affiliations are centered.
- 4. Text of the abstract should be not more than 300words in length and written in 10 pt Regular Arial or Times New Roman. Should be single-spaced and justified.
- 5. Submit the abstract as an attachment of MS Word document via email to the Scientific Papers Committee headed by:

Deadline for submission of abstracts is on **07 November 2008**.
